

SEAPLANE AUTOMATIC LIMITED EDITION [Midnight Landing & Daytrip Models] USER'S MANUAL – OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



Your Seaplane Automatic Limited Edition utilizes an automatic mechanical movement which charges itself from the movement of your arm. It does not have a battery.

When new or not used for an extended period of time, the watch will stop. Once the watch is worn or moved, the movement will become charged and the second hand will begin rotating again. It can also be wound manually via the instructions below.

PARTS OF THE WATCH





SETTING THE TIME & DATE

CROWN POSITIONS



Position 1 – Screwed down and flush with the case.

Position 2 – Unscrewed, manual winding position.

Position 3 – Quick date change

Position 4 – Time setting position

INSTRUCTIONS

- Make sure that your watch is perfectly dry.
- Unscrew the crown counterclockwise and it will move into position 2. If you wish to wind your watch manually, wind the watch 20 times clockwise in this 2nd position.
- Move it to position 3 to set the date. Avoid changing the date between 9:00 pm and 3.00 am. [This can interfere with the jumping mechanism]
 - Recommendation: Set the date for the day before and when setting the time, cross over midnight which will change the date and let you see the AM PM difference.
- Move it to position 4 to set the time. This will stop the movement of the second hand.
- Once adjustments are complete, push the crown back in and screw it down clockwise against the case to preserve its water durability of 10ATM.
- When set down without movement for over the 38 hours of power reserve, the watch will stop. This does not cause damage and is normal with automatic mechanical movements.
